



A-levels for international students



From September 2010 Bell Bedgebury International School Sixth Form will offer a full-time A-level programme.

- A-level is a two-year course and students specialise in three or sometimes four main subjects, enabling them to study these in depth.
- Pre-A-level courses are available from September 2009.
